Our Club is committed to the cultural safety of Aboriginal children, the cultural safety of children from culturally and/or linguistically diverse backgrounds, and to provide a safe environment for children with a disability.

Our Club has specific policies, procedures and training in place to support our leadership team, coaches and volunteers to achieve these commitments.
